







ISB 340

The Cummins ISB has a long reputation as the most fuel-efficient engine in the motorhome industry. The ISB utilizes the Cummins Variable Geometry Turbocharger (VG Turbo) and High Pressure Common Rail (HPCR) fuel system to produce outstanding driveability, integrated exhaust braking and, arguably, the quietest diesel engine in a motorhome today. Its industry-leading fuel economy, extended oil change intervals and minimal maintenance requirements also make the ISB the low-cost-of-ownership leader in its class.

The ISB was developed to optimize every aspect of the engine's operation, utilizing Cummins comprehensive in-house design approach to every engine system from the air intake to the exhaust system. Integration of Cummins advanced electronic controls, VG Turbo, high-pressure fuel system, combustion technology and exhaust aftertreatment is how the ISB delivers on the performance and value expectations of the motorhome owner. And the ISB does it while being certified and compliant to the toughest standards, the 2007 EPA emissions regulations.

The High Pressure Common Rail (HPCR) fuel system and VG Turbo combine to deliver enhanced driveability and improved fuel economy.

Benefits include:

- Outstanding performance with fully integrated design
 - Enhanced High Pressure Common Rail fuel system delivers optimum balance of performance, emissions control and fuel economy across the entire operating range
 - Patented VG Turbo has enhanced response and control with electric actuation for infinite adjustment
 - Cummins Particulate Filter is fully integrated for uncompromising performance, reliability. Reduces particulate matter more than 90%



- Crankcase ventilation system is electronically managed for optimum efficiency and eliminates oil carryover
- Industry-leading fuel economy
 - 24-valve cylinder head provides superior "breathing"
 - Vertical-centered injector position optimizes combustion
 - Cooled Exhaust Gas Recirculation lowers combustion temperatures for reduced emissions and optimized mpg
- Engine braking without additional "add-on" hardware
 - The VG Turbo functions as an engine brake
 - Eliminates exhaust brake maintenance concerns
- Low cost of ownership
 - 15,000-mile (24,000 km) or 1-year oil change intervals
 - "No-adjust" 150,000-mile (240,000 km) engine overhead

- Cummins 15.2-cfm air compressor is optional on ISB (not available on ISB AD)
- Water-in-fuel sensor alerts drivers of contamination that could cause performance and durability problems
- RoadRelay[™] 4 is an onboard monitoring system that provides the driver with trip information such as mpg, engine fault details and optional anti-theft protection



Enhanced Reliability And Durability.

The Cummins ISB is designed for years of dependable use in many different applications, including motorhomes.


- Directed piston cooling
 - Lowers piston and oil ring temperatures
 - Heavy-Duty engine feature
- Vertical-centered fuel injection
 - Results in uniform piston ring temperatures
 - Improves oil consumption control
- The Holset Variable Geometry Turbocharger
 - Enhances reliability because it has only one moving part in the hot exhaust flow
- Integrated combustion air heater
 - Proven durability
 - Eliminates the need for glow plugs or add-on starting aids
- Combination full-flow/bypass lube oil filter
 - Delivers better filtration for longer component life

Electronic Features.

A single ECM (Electronic Control Module) controls the engine and aftertreatment. It also coordinates interaction with the transmission, ABS, engine brake, cooling fan and more. Plus, the ISB has every diagnostic, maintenancemonitoring and engine protection feature that you need.

Exhaust Braking.

The Holset Variable Geometry Turbocharger (VG Turbo) provides exhaust braking without additional add-on hardware in the exhaust system and eliminates exhaust brake maintenance. The operator activates braking by using the brake switch in the driver's compartment. ISB exhaust braking assists in stopping the motorhome while reducing wear on the service brakes.

Cummins ISB is fully compatible with long-life coolant/ antifreeze formulas which allow changes out to six years. Follow maintenance guidelines recommended by the manufacturer for safe use with extended service intervals.

Warranty And Extended Coverage Plans.

Standard Motorhome Warranty (U.S. and Canada only):

The ISB 340 motorhome warranty is 5 years or 100,000 miles (160,935 km), whichever comes first.

The ISB 340 AD motorhome warranty provides coverage for 3 years or 75,000 miles (120,701 km), whichever comes first.


All Cummins motorhome warranties cover:


